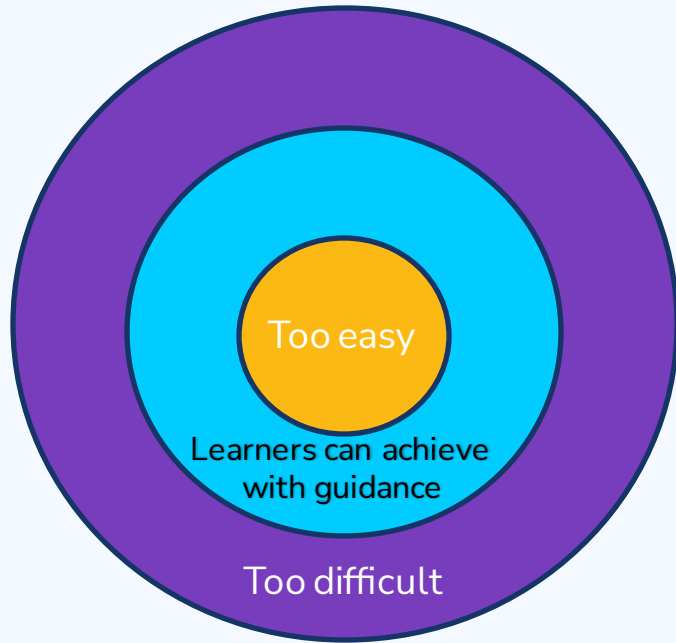

- ✓ This not only raises standards, but also children's confidence!



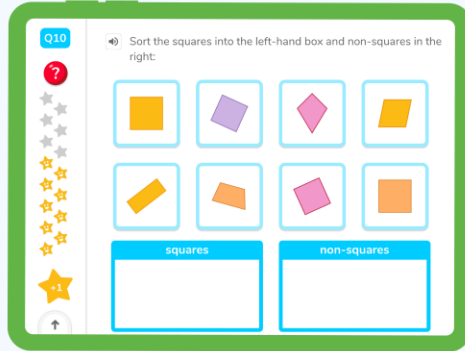
# How does it work?

 Children interact with quick fire exercises, receiving instant feedback

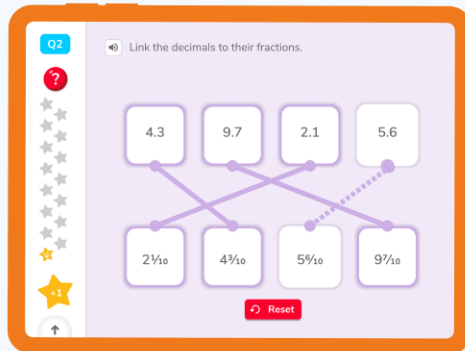
 Our questions maximise the full potential of touchscreen technology

 Every question has a hint and an explanation

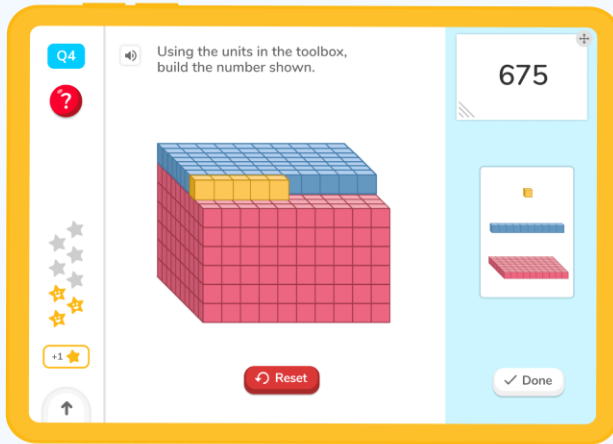
 For children, the increase in difficulty is both gradual and subtle

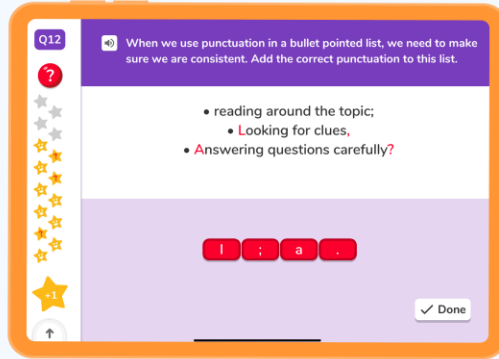

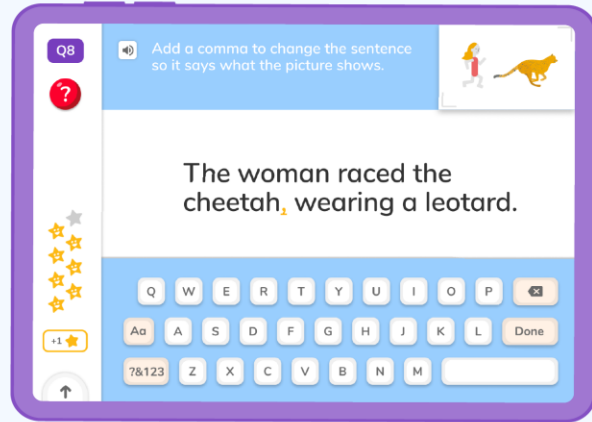


# Use it little and often

# Do children Doodle in class?

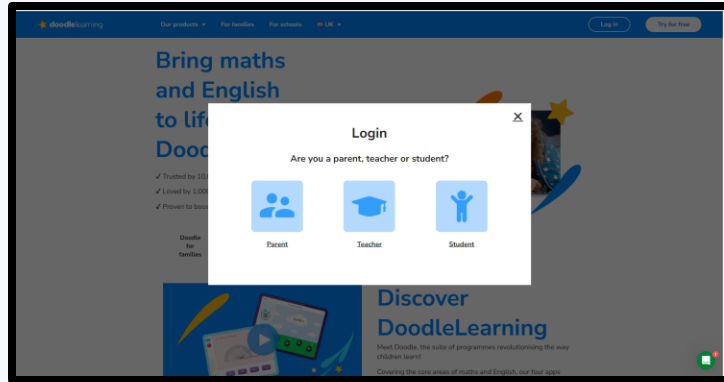
Each child has their own unique learning journey.

# How do the children get started?



 Children login with their unique username and password or by using a class code.

 All children will take a baseline assessment the first time they login. This will ensure that they are working at the right level

 Subsequent questions are used to understand more specific strengths and areas for development

 The more Doodling a child enjoys, the better the programme will support their learning journey, understanding their needs



# After the initial baseline assessment:



💡 Children complete an x-a-day exercise (calibration and revision), a 'new this week' (teaching), a 'power-up (challenge) or an assignment (teacher or parent assigned).

💡 Children need to carry out a sufficient number of x-a-day activities to unlock 'new this week' activities. The number of x-a-day activities varies and is based on age and ability.

💡 If a teacher or parent sets an assignment, this will appear on the child's learning journey to complete, alongside their adaptive learning programme.

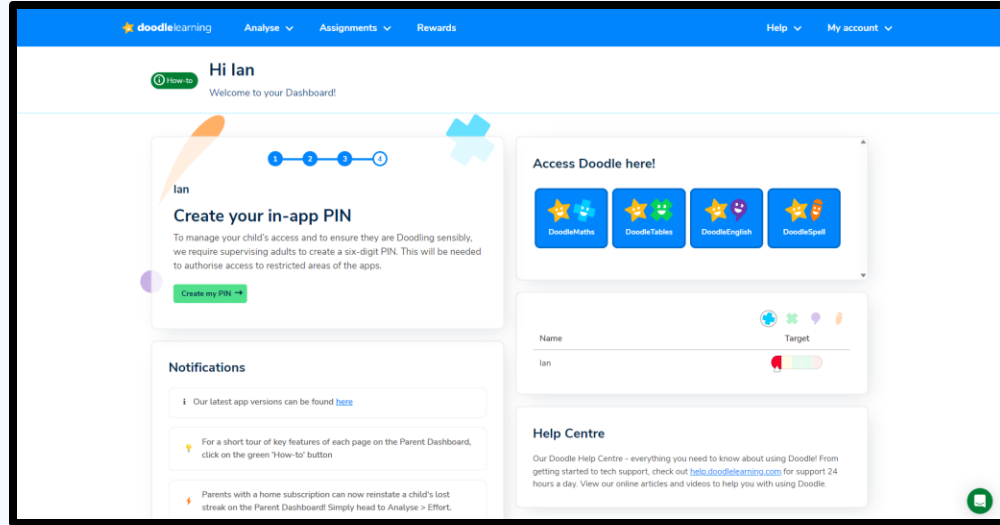

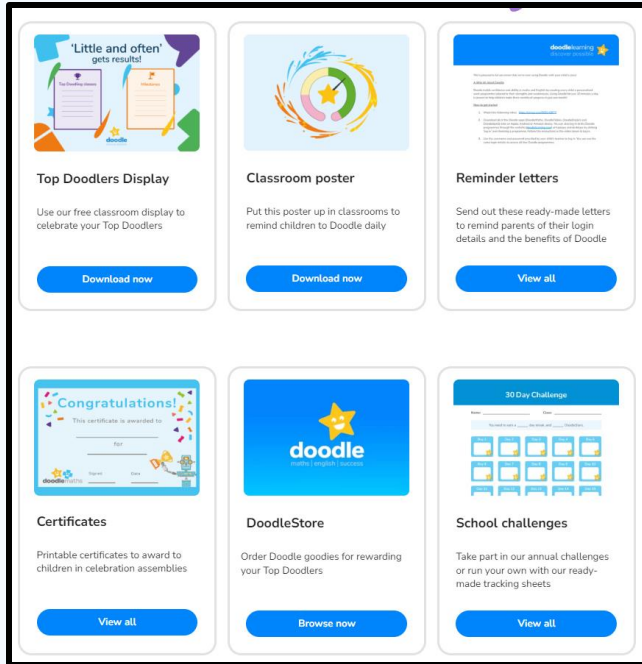
